

MU EHS UNIVERSAL WASTE LABEL INSTRUCTIONS FOR BATTERIES

1. Affix one label to each collection container immediately before you begin using the container.
2. Affix the label to the accumulation container such that:
 - The label is visible from the front of the container.
 - The label is oriented properly (the top of the label is “up”).
3. Mark an “X” in the box to the left of “UNIVERSAL WASTE – BATTERY(IES).”
4. On the line immediately following “ACCUMULATION START DATE,” write the complete date (Month/Day/Year) that you began to accumulate batteries in the container.
5. After the container is filled, determine the inventory of batteries (type(s) and count) and record that information on the line(s) immediately below the accumulation start date.
