

# MU EHS UNIVERSAL WASTE LABEL INSTRUCTIONS FOR LAMPS

1. Affix one label to each collection container immediately before you begin using the container.
2. Affix the label to the accumulation box/drum such that:
  - The label is visible from the front of the box.
  - The label is oriented properly (the top of the label is “up”).
3. Mark an “X” in the box to the left of “UNIVERSAL WASTE – LAMP(S).”
4. On the line immediately following “ACCUMULATION START DATE,” write the complete date (Month/Day/Year) that you began to accumulate lamps in the box/drum.
5. After the box/drum is filled, determine the inventory of lamps (size(s) and count) and record that information on the line(s) immediately below the accumulation start date.
