



Universal Waste Label Instructions For Battery Recycling Boxes

1. Affix one Universal Waste Label to each collection container immediately before you begin using the container.
2. Affix the Universal Waste Label to the battery recycling box such that:
 - The label is visible from the front of the container.
 - The label is oriented properly (the top of the label is “up”).
3. Mark an “X” in the box to the left of the “UNIVERSAL WASTE – BATTERY(IES).”
4. On the line immediately following “ACCUMULATION START DATE,” write the date (Month/Day/Year) of the day in which you began to accumulate batteries in the container.
