

MU EHS HAZARDOUS UNWANTED MATERIALS TEMPORARY ACCUMULATION CONTAINER LABEL INSTRUCTIONS

The following instructions are for use with the MU Environmental Health and Safety (EHS) Hazardous Unwanted Materials Temporary Accumulation Container Label (EHS HML-T 11/21). Some users find it helpful to accumulate used material in a smaller container at their workspace before transferring it into a larger collection container. These smaller containers are often called “day containers” or “transfer containers.” This label is intended for those containers used to accumulate hazardous material until it can be transferred into the larger collection container.

PLEASE NOTE: IN ORDER TO REMAIN COMPLIANT WITH MDNR AND EPA REGULATIONS, THE TRANSFER CONTAINER MUST BE EMPTIED INTO A PROPERLY LABELED COLLECTION CONTAINER **DAILY** (see HML instructions for proper labeling of collection containers).

1. **AFFIX ONE LABEL TO EACH TEMPORARY ACCUMULATION CONTAINER IMMEDIATELY BEFORE YOU BEGIN USING THE CONTAINER FOR THE FIRST TIME.**
2. **LOCATION:** Write the room number and building name (abbreviating as necessary) where the container is used.
3. **PI NAME:** Write the last name of the Permitted Individual (PI) responsible for the material.
4. **NAME OF MATERIAL:** Write a brief descriptive name for the container’s contents (optional).
5. **COMPONENTS:** List the components in the container. Once the material is poured from this temporary accumulation container into the appropriate collection container, these components should be added to the Hazardous Material Label (HML) on the collection container.
6. **HAZARD COMMUNICATION:** Check the box(es) corresponding to the hazard(s) associated with the material. If the hazard is not listed (e.g., mutagen, teratogen, etc.), describe it in the “OTHER” space provided. If the material is non-hazardous, so indicate in the “OTHER” space.
