1. Affix one Universal Waste Label to each collection container immediately before you begin using the container.
2. Affix the Universal Waste Label to the accumulation container such that:
 - The label is visible from the front of the container.
 - The label is oriented properly (the top of the label is “up”).
3. Mark an “X” in the box to the left of “UNIVERSAL WASTE – LAMPS.”
4. On the line immediately following “ACCUMULATION START DATE,” write the date (Month/Day/Year) in which you began to accumulate lamps in the container.
5. After the container is filled, record the type(s) of lamps in the container and the count for each type on the line(s) immediately below the accumulation start date.
